Topic: Artificial Intelligence in Healthcare: Can it lower costs?

Abstract: Artificial intelligence is disrupting healthcare in profound ways. Many discussions have centered around AI replacing doctors. I don't believe this will happen, but I do think there will be two doctors of the future: those who use AI and those who do not. AI will lower costs and help physicians with mundane tasks. Much like Gutenberg's printing press was in the 1400s, AI is now a top disruptive technology that medical practices need to reckon with. Presenter Bio: Jacqueline Havelka is a Texas A&M University biomedical engineering graduate who had a long career at Lockheed Martin as an aerospace contractor for the NASA Johnson Space Center in Houston, Texas. In her 25-year career there, she managed space life sciences experiments and data for the International Space Station & Space Shuttle. She began work on Shuttle mission STS-40 and worked until the last Shuttle launch of STS-135. While at NASA, she served in technical lead and management roles. She was a charter designer of the NASA Life Sciences Data Archive, a repository of NASA human, animal, and biological research, from the Gemini program to the present day. Mrs. Havelka is now a rocket scientist turned writer. In 2016, she founded her own company, Inform Scientific, to provide medical and technical freelance writing. She has always had the desire to start her own business, and she loves the challenge and diversity of international projects that her business brings. In 2017, her husband founded InformAI, a company that builds medical image classifiers and patient outcome predictors. Jacqueline serves as a data scientist, project manager and grant writer for InformAI. She learns something new every single day, and that is a very good thing.
